2024-2025 City League Tennis Teams – E, G, J, & K level

July: form teams **Sept-Dec** fall season **January:** update team roster **Jan-May:** spring season

City League Tennis is a non-profit organization that offers the opportunity to enjoy daytime social and competitive tennis throughout the greater Portland area. Teams are formed at participating tennis facilities within Divisions A-K. Evergreen Tennis has 4 teams: Divisions E, G, J & K. Teams are rostered in July with City League. Players may be added in January; subs are allowed on limited basis. Teams play about one home match and one away match per month September-May. Home team players provide lunch for the home and visiting players.

Team Practices: All practices are opt-in, sign up on the Court Reserve app for those you can make.

E Team: Tuesdays 9:30-11am

G Team: Tuesdays 9:30-11am with E Team, and/or Thursdays 9:30-11am with J Team

J Team: Thursdays 9:30-11am

K Team: Thursdays 11am-12:30pm

Team Captain: Team Coach selects/approves the Captain who may choose a co-Captain. Captains confirm match and courts with other captains. Captains and Coach use TeamSnap to determine player availability and communicate the lineup to players for each match about a week ahead. Captains record score-sheets and enter the scores for each match on the City League site.

Club: The club hosts the visiting team players, pays the City League organization fees, TeamSnap subscription, home match balls, and supplies.

Participant Fees: *All fees will be set up on player's Evergreen Tennis Account.*

City League Fee: \$40/player, assessed in August and assessed in January.

Away Matches: No fees are assessed for away visiting players in City League.

Home Match Court Fee: Included for Advantage Member, \$15 Regular Member.

Team Practice 90 min: \$15 Advantage Member, \$22 Regular Member.

Membership: *All City League team players must be Members of Evergreen Tennis. Please contact the front desk to sign up for membership.*

City League Tennis Rules: Please see full rules at: <http://www.cityleaguetenis.org/>

Please note there are a few rule differences between City League Tennis rules and USTA rules.

- Participants may only play on one city league team.
- Substitute players are pulled up from the next team below, ie: E pulls subs from G, G pulls subs from J, J pulls subs from K, and K may sub in club players who are not rostered on any team.
- Division E matches play on Wednesdays. Division G, J & K matches play on Tuesdays.
- Home Matches on 3 courts: S, D1, D4 play at 11am, arrive by 10:45am. D2, D3 go on next available court and must arrive by noon.
- City League plays 'no-ad' scoring and receiving team can decide which player receives.
- Matches are 2 sets regular no-ad scoring with a 10 point match tie-break for the 3rd set.
- A 7 point set tie-break is used at a set score of 6-6.
- Captains record and enter the scores for each match. Each set won is 1 point.
- Each season, division Team winners move up a level and division losers move down a level.
