

3/16/2020 Short Update regarding Coronavirus (COVID-19) concerns:

**Evergreen Tennis Club is temporarily CLOSED as of Tuesday 3/17/20** by order of the GOVERNOR JAY INSLEE through March 31, 2020, pending further notice. We are following the guidelines set out by the Governor for recreation, fitness and entertainment businesses.

We will be crediting accounts for pre-paid lessons which are canceled. For Advantage memberships, no membership dues will be collected until we confirm a re-open date. All Advantage memberships will be extended for any lost time due to this mandatory closure.

3/13/2020 Short Update regarding Coronavirus (COVID-19) concerns:

We are OPEN and we will continue to follow local health recommendations as they may change and develop. The club will continue with programs and players may opt to attend or opt for a credit on account if they do not attend.

**-DISTANCE-** Player density is low in our 27,000 sf court space. Lessons generally hold 6 players per court. We are asking all players maintain distance from other players by keeping a racquet distance apart with arms extended, this will provide more than the 6 ft spacing recommended by CDC.

**-SCHOOLS-** Washington K-12 schools are canceled through April 24. The club will continue with programs and players may opt to attend or opt for a credit on account.

**-HEALTH-** If you are healthy, come to the club. If you are sick, coughing, fever or low energy, please stay home. Wash your hands with soap for 20 seconds frequently throughout the day. Our club surfaces are cleaned frequently throughout the day.

We pride ourselves in our service and care for our members, players and the staff at Evergreen Tennis.
